Confidentiality of Student Records (FERPA)

At NMSU, we recognize the vital role others may play in the success of our student's education. For some students, it is the parents who pay for their child's education. While we understand that many questions arise, it is our obligation under the **Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA)** to comply with each student's right to privacy.

Providing Access to Parents/Guardians/Spouses/Friends

NMSU Students may provide "proxy access" to parents/guardians /spouses/friends as desired by going online at myNMSU using the Proxy Access tab. Students can itemize the areas to which their proxies may have access; for example, students may wish their proxy to be able to view the tuition bill, financial aid requirements, academic grades or schedule. By setting up proxy access, the student permits their proxy to view such information online, as well as their proxy to have discussions about such information with University Accounts Receivable staff members.

General Information

By enrolling in classes at New Mexico State University (NMSU), a student makes a financial commitment to pay the tuition and fee charges associated with that enrollment. The enrollment action constitutes a financial obligation between the student and NMSU and all proceeds of this agreement will be used for educational purposes and constitute an educational loan pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 523(a) (8).

It is important to know that tuition and fees vary by campus site, level, and residency status. Tuition, fees, housing, and meal charges are assessed each semester. Housing and meal plan charges are based on the type of room or plan selected. (Consult the housing and meal plan contracts for exact amount due).

Upon registration, a "Class Schedule and Statement of Account" is e-mailed to the student's nmsu.edu e-mail address. This document contains semester courses enrolled, financial aid information and tuition and fee charges assessed.

NMSU sends monthly electronic billing statements to each student having an account balance due. A student may view his/her statement e-bill via myNMSU. It is the student's responsibility to pay tuition, fees and other expenses by the due date published.
